3) Our Purpose, Deliverables, and Guidelines (9:07 - 9:38)

- The group reviewed a draft Committee Charter and gave comments and feedback to refine the Committee and Working Group format, operating guidelines, decision making process, and communication methods. Specific ideas/edits included:

4) EPA Community Change Grant Application (9:38 - 9:55)

 BACTS and BASWG will be leading an application for the Bangor region to support the following projects: Resilience Hub Networking and Upgrade Project, Active Transportation Planning and Engineering Study, and a Stormwater Management Project. We will be requesting \$20million to implement these projects over the course of three years. The PCA Committee will oversee the grant and Working Groups will be created to support each of the three projects.

<u>Resulting Action</u>: Those interested can review the application and provide comments by 10/24 at noon. We will discuss Working Group creation if/when we are awarded the funding.
